Notes:

1. 20-minutes halves. Clock stops: last minute of 1st half, last 2 mins. Of 2nd half and after each basket the last 30 sec. of the game and OT
2. 2 timeouts per regulation, anytime. One timeout per OT. Timeouts are 1 minute. Teams must be on court, ready to play at the end of 1 minute timeout.
3. All technical fouls are 2 shots, and if unsportsmanlike, are also charged as personal foul.
4. Grace period 5 minutes from scheduled game time.
5. No eating, drinking or smoking in facilities.
6. Lock up all valuables.
7. Uniform jerseys must be numbered (front and back).
8. **Official Fees - \$40.00 per team (CASH ONLY).**
