To Operate With Propane You Will Need:

1. Have all propane tanks secured so they cannot tip over, be pushed over, or moved out of position. This includes 20# propane tanks that are used with most gas grills. Initial: _____
2. Have a fire extinguisher with proof it is within one year of certification, and must be located within easy reach to use. Fire Extinguisher must be a minimum size of 10 ABC. Initial: _____
3. All propane hoses or piping needs to be in good working condition and properly supported, and not pose a trip hazard. All connections must be checked for leaks with a soapy water solution: Initial: _____

Permit issued under the provisions of the NYS Fire Prevention and Building Code. City Fire ordinance #50, Article 21, Section 21.3, NFPA 58.

The City of Syracuse Fire Prevention Bureau shall approve use of Propane within the City of Syracuse. Permits are conditional upon inspection.

Inspection will include, but not limited to: Tanks secured, fire extinguisher, hoses or pipes, location, and appliances.

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WARNING TO ALL PROPANE USERS

LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS IS DANGEROUS

Please review the information and following suggested guidelines:

1. Propane may not be used inside buildings for cooking.
2. Propane tanks may not be stored in buildings without approval.
3. Propane tanks may not be in public buildings without approval.
4. Do not transport tanks in trunk of car or unsecured.
5. Make sure properly connected tanks are tight and not leaking prior to each use.
6. Must have a fire extinguisher nearby, minimum of 10 ABC rating.
7. Small tanks and cassette table top units are not permitted for restaurant/catering use.
8. Tanks are to be secured by chain, wire, or metal strap and 10' from all ignition sources.
9. Permits are required by City Code for Commercial use.
10. Outside 20' from exit doors, stairways, and other means of egress.
11. Regulators, piping, and containers must be protected from vehicular damage.
