Training Classes Begin on March 19, Prerequisite Swim Testing Currently Offered

SYRACUSE, N.Y. – The City of Syracuse Department of Parks, Recreation, and Youth Programs is currently seeking candidates for lifeguard positions during the summer months. The Department will offer training classes for those interested but currently without certifications.
