Post Card issue addressed (6 addresses), possibility of producing flyers to be displayed in key locations (Volunteer residents to distribute)

IX. NYSDOT Region / C&S Engineering

George Doucette presentation on the NYSDOT I690 Teall Ave/Beech St Project. Proposed 2 Roundabouts, eliminating traffic signals and creating slower traffic movement. 15' span from Beech st to Teal Ave to be replaced with polystyrene blocks held by an earth retaining wall. (opportunity for artists to design a more aesthetically pleasing façade for the wall) Project timeline: acquiring the right of way by summer 2017. Fall 2017 open bids on the project. Construction completed by end of 2019. Public meeting outreach TBA.

Resident concerns: reducing some areas to one lane (eliminating an emergency lane), creating a back up of traffic during SU Basketball games. Roundabout in interchange does not adequately address bike traffic (specifically children going to and from school). Request for alternate route options (Divine Street as the back entrance to the Post office).
