Priority Area I: Infrastructure

- Sensors for leaks in Water Mains (better coordinate services)
- Computer installed in a vehicle to map pot holes throughout city
- utility upgrades, sewer replacement, water main replacement: a few per year due to expense of these upgrades
- Construction map added to city website: allows residents to track construction projects throughout entire city

- Allows you to see a map of construction projects throughout city
- Tracking number for issues submitted to city departments (allows you to see where the issue is within the city departments)
- Improved efficiency of notifying public on Road Closers
