II. Updates on Special Projects

- 2) Richard Zelewski has sign quote from Fossil & Syracuse Blueprint. Location has been decided for Washington Square Park. Content is still being developed

- 1) Cornell: Butternut St. has had 4-5 trees removed that need replacement
- 2) CNY Services: Various Housing types throughout city & suburbs
 - Developing 40 single apartments 10 double on the 500 block of Catherine St.
 - 30 rented to mental health individuals, 20 to low income (intermixed)
 - CNY working with Christopher Community for Section 8 Vouchers
 - HUD funding will not allow for sexual predators to rent at this property
