## **III. Police Chief Frank Fowler**

### **1)What are the Crime Statistics for the Northside & City-wide?**

Overall Crime down from last year. There is a Crime Analysis Center that collects and houses data and info. There are specialized areas in tracking specific crimes such as burglaries or drug/gang/violence.

### **2)Will there be more officers on the Northside?**

Currently, they are halfway through the hiring process for 30 new officers. However, there will be many officers retiring. The new hires could balance our the officers retiring.

### **3)Will there be use of body cameras and cameras on the Northside.**

There will be a pilot program where a handful of officers will wear body cameras. This pilot program will be used to write for grants from the Federal Government. Policy regarding the use of body cameras is currently underway. Cameras have helped to reduce crime. There is discussion on the possible use of an Analytics program to do Live Monitoring of the Police Cameras.

### **4)Is there anything Citizens can do to help the Police?**
