A) Bob Dougherty: County Storm Water reduction plan  
 High cost for storm water plan, could have greater impact on smaller businesses as the county is pushing to reduce storm water runoff from 10,000 sq ft to 5,000 sq ft only in priority areas. As well as push development of new business out of the city.
