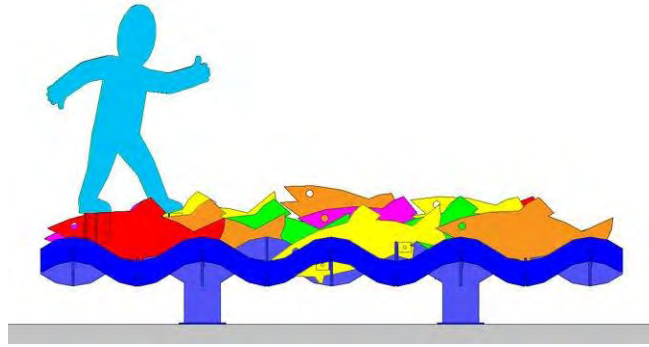


HONORING ONONDAGA CREEK

In collaboration with the Onondaga Nation, Valley TNT and the Syracuse Public Art Commission, artist Peter Michel created a sculpture along Onondaga Creek on West Seneca Turnpike. This sculpture, in memory of Onondaga legend, depicts a boy crossing the creek along the backs of the fish that were so plentiful at that time. It is the hope of all that the Creek will some day return to its original beauty where we will have 'fish so plentiful' once again. Donations will support a dedication plaque and maintenance.
