NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held Monday, January 24, 2011, at 6:00 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers, City Hall, Syracuse, New York to consider in full, or in part, the following applications. Please note this is not necessarily the order in which they will be heard.

Application No. SP-10-29, for a special permit to establish a gasoline service station on property located at 680 South Salina Street, owned by the Ekam Corp., zoned Commercial, Class A, pursuant to Part B, Section V, Article 1, and Part C, Section IV, Article 2 of the Zoning Rules and Regulations for the City of Syracuse, as amended.

Application No. SP-10-30, for a special permit to establish a light-duty, motor vehicle repair shop on property located at 2525-2527 South Salina Street, owned by Mavis Discount Tire, zoned Business, Class A, pursuant to Part B, Section III, Article 2, and Part C, Section IV, Article 1 of the Zoning Rules and Regulations for the City of Syracuse, as amended.

Application No. R-10-41, to resubdivide four parcels into two new Lots on property situated at 406, 408, 410-14 & 418 Sunset Avenue, owned by Mary A. Iorio, zoned Industrial, Class A, pursuant to the Subdivision Rules and Regulations of the City of Syracuse.

Application No. R-10-42, to resubdivide two parcels into one New Lot on property situated at 410 and 412 Oswego Street, owned by Home Headquarters, zoned Business, Class A, pursuant to the Subdivision Rules and Regulations of the City of Syracuse.

Application No. 3S-10-17, for a Three-Mile Limit Review to subdivide 13.9 acres into nine new Lots as part of the 84-lot Steinway Heights Subdivision on property situated on Wentworth Drive in the Town of DeWitt, owned by John Murphy pursuant to the City of Syracuse Three-Mile Limit Review.

Application No. 3S-10-18, for a Three-Mile Limit Review to subdivide 2.75 acres into two new Lots on property situated on East Molloy Road in the Town of DeWitt, owned by Stephen H. LaBarge pursuant to the City of Syracuse Three-Mile Limit Review.
